The Pierian Journal Submission Guidelines

General Information

The Pierian accepts original work that has not been published previously.

Submissions made simultaneously are accepted. In the event your work is accepted elsewhere, you must inform us as soon as possible by emailing the editors at ThePierian@asurams.edu.

The Pierian claims first serial rights. All rights revert to the author/artist upon publication.

A 400 character maximum biographical note, written in the third person, must be included with submissions. There is a space in the online submission form for your bio.

Each submission window allows for the inclusion of up to 3 individual works in one submission. Any combination of written works and/or visual arts may be included. Only 1 submission is allowed per person.

Accepted email notifications arrive by May 15 with online publication released Sept 15.

Literature Submissions

- Short fiction up to 2500 words; Nonfiction up to 2000 words. Poetry formatting will follow submission as best as possible.
- Literature submissions must be in .docx format.
- Filename must be in the following format:

FirstName-LastName--Title.docx

Example: George-Williams—The-Gateways.docx

Visual Arts Submissions

- We encourage submissions of any visual art that can be submitted in a single 2D format. Drawing, painting, collage, mixed media, photography, graphic design, sculpture, ceramics, performance art, and video stills are just a few examples.
- Visual Art Submissions must be in .jpg format, 2500 pixels on the long side, sRGB color profile. If
 published the submitted image will not be edited, but may be reduced in size to fit the publication or
 cropped to have the background removed.
- Filename must be in the following format: FirstName-LastName--Artwork-Title.jpg
 Example: Jasmine-Smith—Ghost-Among-Us.jpg
